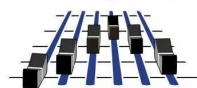

- Please inform your venue manager that we will arrive 2 hours before the guests arrive for setup. (Note: It takes approximately 1 hour to set up and dismantle a full DJ and lighting set up.)
- We do provide our own table.

Consider setting your DJ station so that it is not in view of photo and filming opportunities. Also, please try and locate the DJ station as close to the dance floor as possible. (This seems to help guests feel more comfortable interacting with the DJ's and requesting songs.)
- We request that all forms and music lists be returned to BAMMM within 2 weeks of the event. If you are having trouble deciding on some songs we will help you when we meet with you.

If you have special music, provide us with a USB drive or email to BAMMM one week prior to the event.
